Furthermore we focus on your improved profit from better reproduction and using **GenVik** – genomic selection **X-Vik** – sexed semen – and **Heatime** – automatic heat observation.

On Tuesday **RDC** and **Jersey** will have their **winter shows** and on Wednesday Denmark's best **black and red Holstein** cows will compete for honourable titles. Wednesday night we have top genetics at the Holstein auction.

D Limbo (Lancelot x T Funkis) – high-yielding Lancelot son with top health. The daughters are high-yielding, fertile, high milking speed and calves easily.

D Orange (Oman Justi x T Funkis) – one of the world's best Oman sons with NTM +38. Protein production, fertility, health and functional conformation.

D Ole (Oman x Jocko Besn) – the perfect allround bull for modern production systems. Fertility, udder health, milking speed and yield in top.

Jersey progeny groups

DJ Jante (M Jace x ØDA Rix) – high yield, large daughters, prime teat traits and outstanding fertility and udder health.

DJ Give (Q Hov x JAS Tabic) – strong feet and legs and super mammary combined with fertility and udder health at a high level.

DJ Zuma (Q Zik x FYN Lemvig) – high production index with ideal combination of fat and protein. Very strong feet and legs and prime udder. Fertility and udder health utmost positive.

RDC progeny groups

R Fastrup (Orraryd x Stadel) – high yield and super conformation with feet and legs, female fertility, milking speed and temper in top. Very well suited for milking robots. High birth index.

R Bangkok (T Fjembe x Tor Bruno) – allround bull with super health and conformation, rear teat placement combined with fast milking speed suits the daughters well for milking robots.

R Facet (K Jerry x Vættergård) – super conformation and health. Outstanding mammary and feet & legs combined with progress in udder health, calving ability, fertility and milking speed.
